

DRUMS TO FOH

Drums can be routed to FOH as normal, with the exception of **kick and snare**, which should be routed through rack unit first. In order to do this **2 additional XLR cables from venue are required**. FOH can patch into rack unit and receive a regular dry kick and snare signal.



*If required, Samples L/R, Backing Vox L/R, Guitars L/R, Piano L/R can be bundled into 1 stereo track

Rack All instruments -including kick and snare- are routed through our rack unit and can be patched into by FOH from either channel splitter or interface
